#### Uniform

**Polos** – Black shoes and socks, Black long pants. Girls my wear a black modest (i.e. hem is below the knees when sitting) skirt instead of trousers/slacks but black stockings will also be worn.

Polo shirt\* and cap\* supplied on loan with first performance. Polo shirt will be tucked into the Pants/trousers/slacks/skirt with lower button fastened during performances.

Cold weather jumper\* supplied when needed. Jumper to worn with shirt collar outside the jumper. \* A security deposit is required when uniform is loaned.

**Whites** – Black trousers/skirt shoes & socks/stockings as above, white shirt and red bow tie and red cummerbund OR green bow tie and green cummerbund for 1<sup>st</sup> year students. (Jacket, bowtie and cummerbund supplied on loan by QSHBA)

Hair styles are own choice but must be neat and tidy. Hair that can be tied back should be tied back and kept away from the face during performances and rehearsals.

#### **Communications**

Notes to take home are not used in BYB. Verbal communication occurs during rehearsals to both the students and when available, to parents/careers.

The main method is electronic via email, our facebook page and the "What's On" page of our website. Phone communication in a more urgent situation is also used.

### Requirements

#### All students should have

- Pencil and rubber
- A4 4 ring binder (Music does not sit vertical with less than 4 rings)
- A4 plastic page protectors (look for non-reflective brand)
- 4 pegs (Wind is always a problem. The pegs can clip onto the 4 rings)
- Water bottle (when uniform is issued a water bottle cover is included)
- Instrument screwdriver set (\$2.95 at Dollar Tree in Edith St.)
- Home practice music stand (watch ALDI catalogue for approx. \$26.00 special)
- Absorbent pad for water drippings from wind instruments
- Positive attitude

### **Sun Safe Practices**

QSHBA performances and some rehearsals might require members to be in direct sunlight. QSHBA actively minimises the risk of sun damage however, this can only be done with the co-operation of all members

QSHBA always attempts to maximise usage of natural shade and/or provide shade facilities however, all members should:

- · Wear uniform hat or, when not directly "on stage", wear an own choice hat
- Use sunscreen provided or own choice sunscreen (30+ or more)
- Re-apply sunscreen at the recommended intervals
- During "off stage" times, remain in the shade as much as is possible
- Advise a leadership team member at any time the member feels that sun burn (damage) is about to occur.
- Wear sunglasses when practicable and possible
- Understand that dehydration is also a form of sun damage and therefore drink adequate amounts of water. (Flavoured water or water with other additives, is not recommended as a protection against dehydration)
- Have a personal water bottle carried in the QSHBA water bottle carrier provided.
- Understand that overheating is also form of sun damage and report any instances of feeling unwell even if you think it is not related to the sun or heat
- Understand that cold or overcast weather conditions do not prevent sun damage.

#### **CHILD SAFETY**

### **Additional Requirements**

#### Flute

cleaning cloth and rod (or pull-through)

#### Oboe, Clarinet & Saxophones

- cleaning cloth and pull-through
- 4 X size 1½ (for beginners) reeds (replacement reeds should progressively increase in size. Thus the second purchase should be 2 X 2 and 2 X 2½)
- Cork grease (not for oboe)

### Cornet, Trumpet, Horn, Baritone, Euphonium, Trombone & Bass

- Valve oil (slide oil for Trombone)
- Tuning slide grease (petroleum Gel)
- Polishing cloth
- Mouthpiece brush
- For trombone Slide cleaning "snake"

#### Guitar \*Electric Guitar only

- Spare strings
- Power plug board and extension lead\*
- Guitar leads X 2\*
- Electronic tuner (two way input port and output port; or vibrational attachment)
- Guitar Amp\*

#### Percussion

- Drum sticks and Glockenspiel sticks (initially the cheapest)
- Stick bag (holds all sticks, has carry strap and hanging Hooks/straps
- Practice pad (black "re-bounder" preferred)

#### Electric Keyboard:

Power plug board and extension lead.
