NOTES FOR THE CONDUCTOR

"First Concert Medley No 2" has been written as beginner piece to be played in unison and therefore playable by any instrument, or combination of instruments, for a first concert performance. If this still proves to be beyond the stamina level required, then the piece may be broken-up into the individual tunes.

Lyrics have been included to not only assist with rehearsals but to also allow for an added dimension to the performance.

F Brass and Eb Brass have difficulty with the unison method because the required notes are either too high or too low. Too assist with this, there are lower parts written at the same written pitch as the Bb instruments which, is generally more achievable by these instruments. This does however create the problem of parallel 4ths or 5ths. Choose the parts that suit your programme best i.e. controlled parallel 4ths and 5ths or, uncontrolled miss-pitching in trying to achieve a unison sound. This only works if you have one or the other thus there is a third option for the Eb Brass to bring them into unison with the F brass if you have both. Again, choose the parts that best fit your situation.

There are also two mallet parts, one written an octave below the other. This caters for the two different methods for teaching mallets. Lower brass comes in both G clef and F clef to again cater for the teaching method used in you programme.

All parts have fingering diagrams for the notes used on any particular part.

The following teaching points are covered in this arrangement.

- © Rhythm Minims, Crotchets, Semibreves and, whole bar rests.
- © Ensemble Unison
- © Percussion Mallets: Glockenspiel high and/or low octave
 - Timpani: Two or three notes

Drums: Snare, Bass and, on the rims (cymbals are not included because at his level, players are only required to play three notes.

Auxillary: Triangle, Tambourine and Woodblock/Cowbell

Whilst parts are included for these percussion instruments, it is not essential that all are played - on the other hand it ensures that there is plenty to do if you have a large section. Practice on all four subsections of percussion is thus also available if the instruments are available.


