NOTES FOR THE CONDUCTOR

"First Concert Duet Medley NO 5" is the sequel to "First Concert Medley" and "First Concert Duet Medley" This duet expands the previous duet by one additional note (Concert Eb).

It has been written as beginner piece to be played in two part unison and therefore playable by any instrument, or combination of instruments, for a very beginner concert performance. If this still proves to be beyond the stamina level required, then the piece may be broken-up into the individual tunes.

Lyrics have been included to not only assist with phrasing and rehearsals, but to also allow for an added dimension to the performance.

At this level, F Brass and Eb Brass have difficulty with the unison method because the required notes are either too high or too low. Too assist with this, there are harmony parts written at the same written pitch as the Bb instruments which, is generally more achievable by these instruments. This does however mean that when using the harmony parts, they do not get to play the melody. Choose the parts that best suit your student in programme.

There are also two mallet parts, one written an octave below the other. This caters for the two different methods for teaching mallets. Lower brass comes in both G clef and F clef to again cater for the teaching method used in you programme. There is also a drum kit part which combines the Drums A and B parts for one player.

All parts have fingering diagrams for the notes used on a particular part.

The following teaching points are covered in this arrangement.

- © Rhythm Minims, Crotchets, Semibreves and, whole bar rests.
- © Ensemble Duet in two part unison i.e. all part As are in unison and all Part Bs are in unison.
- © Percussion Mallets: Glockenspiel high and/or low octave

Timpani: Two, three or four notes

Drums: Snare, Bass, Ride Cymbal and Crash Cymbal

Auxillary: Triangle, Tambourine, Woodblock/Cowbell and Hand Cymbals

Whilst parts are included for these percussion instruments, it is not essential that all are played - on the other hand it ensures that there is plenty to do if you have a large section. Practice on all four subsections of percussion is thus also available if the instruments are available.

An album of 2, 3, 4 and 5 note tunes to be played in unison. Semibreves, minims, crotchets and some rests. Includes warmups, two simple theory tests, and fingering charts. Percussion part covers four areas of percussion. Includes duets, and trios working up to band arrangements using only the first five notes of the Concert Bb scale (D Scale for Strings) in common time. One part per instrument. The easiest charts around

"FIRST CONCERT MEDLEY"

A medley of four simple three note tunes, all played in unison across the Band. An easy piece to get off the ground. Includes - "Rain is Falling Down", "When I Make My Music", "Down by the Station" and "Hot Cross Buns" Range: Concert pitch Bb, C, & D. — Semi-Breves, Minims and Crotchets, Whole bar rests.

"FIRST CONCERT DUET MEDLEY"

A medley of five simple four note tunes, played as a duet across the Band. All players can play either part A or Part B. An easy piece to get off the ground. Includes - "Watermelon Custard" "Lindy Loo", "On the Beach" "Here Comes Fred" & "Let's all Hit the Floor" Range: Concert pitch A, Bb, C, D, and a foot stomp at the end. - Semi-Breves, Minims and Crotchets, Whole bar rests.

Uses minims, crotchets and equivalent rests. Range Concert Bb to F. Opt. piano part included.

"MERRILY AND FRIENDS"

Uses minims, crotchets and equivalent rests. Range Concert Bb to F. Opt. piano part included. Includes "Merrily We Roll Along", "Aura Lee" & "Johnny Works With One Hammer"

"BILBY BOMP"

Uses minims, crotchets and equivalent rests.

Range Concert Bb to F. Opt. piano part included. The intro. and the bass line are melodies in there own right also.

"HOT CROSS BUNS AND FRIENDS"

Includes "Rain is Falling Down, Mary had a Little Lamb & Wiggle Wobble". Semibreves, minims, crotchets and equivalent rests Range Concert Bb to F. Opt. piano part included.

"DOWN BY THE STATION AND FRIENDS"

Semibreves, minims, crotchets and equivalent rests

Range Concert Bb to F. Opt. piano part included.

Includes "Song of Joy", "Drum Away", "Ring, Ring, Ring the Bell"

"MARCH SOUTH"

Uses minims, crotchets and equivalent rests with additional emphasis on rests.
Range Concert A to F. Opt. piano part included.

"MARCH KIN KORA"

Semibreves, minims, crotchets and equivalent rests, plus paired same-pitch quavers.

Range Concert Bb to F. Opt. piano part included.

"ROWHAN'S SONG"

Semibreves, minims, crotchets and equivalent rests, plus paired same-pitch quavers. Based on 12Bar pattern. Range Concert Bb to F. Opt. piano part included.

"RING A ROSIE AND FRIENDS

Semibreves, minims, crotchets & same pitch paired quavers.

Range Con. A to F (C#, D, E, F#, G, A for strings). Opt. piano part included.

"LIGHTLY ROW AND FRIENDS"

Semibreves, minims, crotchets & same pitch paired quavers.

Range Con. A to F (C#, D, E, F#, G, A for strings). Opt. piano part included.

"CHA CHA MOOD"

Semibreves, minims, crotchets & same pitch paired quavers. Introduces Cha Cha rhythm. Range Con. A to F (C#, D, E, F#, G, A for strings). Opt. piano part included.

"ROCK MOOD"

Semibreves, minims, crotchets & same pitch paired quavers in groups of four Quavers Range Con. A to G (C#, D, E, F#, G, A for strings). Opt. piano part included.

"DROP BEAR"

Semibreves, minims, crotchets & same pitch paired quavers in groups of four Quavers. Range Con. G to G (B, D, E, F#, G, B for strings). Opt. piano part included. Introduces programme music by telling the story of encountering Drop Bears when walking through the Australian bush.

"TANGO MOOD"

A developmental piece for school bands, no clarinets above the break, sufficient cues to play with a reduced size band. Introduces the Argentine Tango Rhythm. And divisi. Range - Concert Ab & A to F. Excellent for teaching chromatic alt. fingering for Clarinets and saxophones

"RHUMBA MOOD"

Constructed in 1st. & 2nd. parts using the range concert A Bb C D Eb E F G, 2nd parts do not have the Concert E and not all players use the lower note Concert A. As the Con E & Eb are generally consecutive, this is an excellent chart for teaching not only Rumba rhythm but also for correct use of chromatic alternative fingering and learning the difference. All sections get a go at melody. Form is - Intro A B A C A coda. passages B & C are optional Solo or section soli.

The intro. and the bass line are melodies in there own right also.

"SWING MOOD" (Young Concert Band) \$55.00

A developmental piece for school bands, no clarinets above the break, sufficient cues to

play with a reduced size band. Range - Concert Ab A Bb C D Eb E F

"AURA LEE"

Three verses, clarinets are not above the break and brass are not above treble clef Bb, most inner parts within concert Bb to F. No quavers. Range - Concert Ab to F

"MAN FROM SNOWY RIVER"

The main theme from the movie. Range con Bb to Bb, and Db. Clarinets not above break

"FANFARE"

For learner Bands All BB parts comply to A.M.E.B. Band Grade 2. For CB the clarinets are not above the break and brass are not above C. Similar ranges for other instruments.

"FLINTSTONES"

The T.V. Theme arranged with the young band in mind. All the complicated fills are simplified. Concert band – no clarinets above the break and compatible ranges for other instruments, Brass band – no one above C in the stave.

"ATONALITY MOOD"

Chromatic piece in soft rock style introducing none standard cadences. Range, compound 6th, concert G to E

"MOVE BABY MOVE"

The Johnny O'Keefe song arranged for the young concert Band. 1st clar. Only above the break. For band or band with vocal soloist. A great rock standard.

"HAIL THE CONQUERING HERO" (Young Concert Band) \$55.00

Trumpet feature on Handle's popular piece. Range compound 4th. Concert G to C, lower range for 2nd & 3rd parts.

"BOSSA NOVA MOOD" - Developing Concert Band \$55.00 cat 096M1 Introduces Bossa Nova rhythm and 1st, 2nd,and 3rd parts, range compound 7th concert G to F for lead parts, lower ranges for inner parts.







The plucking indicators above i.e., Middle finger or Ring finger, are generic for when there is single note on the string. When there are consecutive notes on the one strring, two fingers are generally used and are alternated between notes. Therefore the suggested plucking for Part A from bar 45 above is, 45: I, M, I; 46: M, I, M, I; 47: M, I, M, I; 48; M






Eb SAXOPHONE Alto and Baritone
